An alternative signaling strategy, exploited in particular in the nervous system, is to use ion channels to allow controlled movement of monovalent ( $\text{Na}^+$ ,  $\text{K}^+$ ) or divalent ( $\text{Ca}^{2+}$ ) cations in or out of the cell, resulting in changes in membrane potential or alterations in the intracellular concentration of  $\text{Ca}^{2+}$ . Part II of this volume is concerned with these ion channels and with other, often simpler, ion channel systems whose study can throw light on channel mechanism.
