First published in 1972,  
Handbook for History Teachers  
is intended to be a general and  
comprehensive work of  
reference for teachers of  
history in primary and

secondary schools of all kinds.  
The book covers all aspects of  
teaching history: among them  
are the use of sources, world  
history, art and history;  
principles of constructing a  
syllabus and the psychological  
aspects of history teaching. The  
bibliographical sections are  
arranged on three parts: school  
textbooks, a section on audio-  
visual-aids and, finally, books  
for the teacher and possibly for  
the sixth form. It thoroughly  
investigates and critiques the  
various methods employed in  
teaching history within  
classrooms and suggests  
alternatives wherever  
applicable. Diligently curated  
by the Standing Sub-  
Committee in History,

University of London Institute  
of Education, the book still  
holds immense value in the  
understanding of pedagogy.  
Contains 92 outline maps. The  
first 70 of these are historical  
outline maps of important  
developments in American  
history, including European  
explorations, the American  
Revolution, United States  
expansion, and United States  
post-World War II policy. Maps  
71-81 are outline maps of  
current world regions.  
Genealogical research in U.S.  
censuses begins with  
identifying correct county  
jurisdictions ??o assist in this  
identification, the map Guide  
shows all U.S. county  
boundaries from 1790 to 1920.

On each of the nearly 400 maps the old county lines are superimposed over the modern ones to highlight the boundary changes at ten-year intervals. Accompanying each map are explanations of boundary changes, notes about the census, & tocality finding keys. In addition, there are inset maps which clarify ??erritorial lines, a state-by-state bibliography of sources, & an appendix outlining pitfalls in mapping county boundaries. Finally, there is an index which lists all present day counties,
