Contingency refers to an event that may be happening in future, but also may not happen. The concept plays has a long history dating from Aristotle who defined contingency as that which is possible but not necessary. The concept of contingency and related concepts as free will, the rejection of essentialisation and priority of the possible put a major challenge to theology in the 21st century. The book addresses this challenge from the perspective of practical theology. In doing so, it connects to the general debate in theology on naming God, hermeneutics, human agency and methodology. This concise edition of the definitive 3-volume Dictionary of European Proverbs constitutes a fascinating collection of proverbs in 29 languages. The Concise Dictionary of European Proverbs is based on over 40 years in-depth research by the compiler. It is an essential reference source for linguists, ethnologists and folklorists, and of interest to anyone wanting to know about the origins, development and current usage of the proverb. Emanuel Strauss is a world-renowned expert on proverbs. *Comedy and Crisis* contains the first ever scholarly English translation of Pieter Langendijk's *Quincampoix, or the Wind Traders* [*Quincampoix of de Windhandelaars*], and *Harlequin Stock-Jobber* [*Arlequin Actionist*]. The first play is a full-length satirical comedy, and the second is a short, comic harlequinade; both were written in Dutch in response to the speculative financial crisis or bubble of 1720 and were performed in Amsterdam in the fall of 1720, as the bubble in the Netherlands was bursting. *Comedy and Crisis* also contains our translation of the extensive apparatus prepared by C.H.P. Meijer (Introduction and notes) for his 1892 edition of these plays. The current editors have updated the footnotes and

added six new critical essays by contemporary literary and historical scholars that contextualize the two plays historically and culturally. The book includes an extensive bibliography and index. The materials assembled in *Comedy and Crisis* are a rich resource for cultural, historical, and literary students of the history of finance and of eighteenth-century studies. The twenty essays that comprise this book, which was first published in 1994, were written by leading paremiologists and folklorists from Africa, Canada, Great Britain, Germany and the US. They represent the best scholarship on proverbs in the English language, and together they give an impressive overview of the fascinating advances in the field of paremiology. Darin widmet sich der Germanist und Folklorist seinem Thema aus einem sprachkulturellen, literarischen und politischen Blickwinkel und vergleicht sowohl deutsch- als auch englischsprachige Sprichwörter hinsichtlich ihrer Genese und ihres Fortwirkens: Luthers sprichwörtliche Argumentationen werden hier vom Autor ebenso wie das sprichwörtliche Wirken in den Werken Nietzsches und Brechts sowie den Reden Martin Luther Kings und Willy Brandts in den Fokus gerückt. Wolfgang Mieder (geb. 1944) ist seit 1971 Professor für Germanistik und Volkskunde an der University of Vermont in Burlington, Vermont (USA), wo er über drei Jahrzehnte Leiter des Instituts für Germanistik und Slawistik war. Obwohl er sich mit Märchen, Sagen und Volksliedern sowie philologischen und literarischen Themen beschäftigt, liegt sein hauptsächliches Forschungsinteresse in der Paremiologie, d.h. in der Sprichwörterforschung. Viele seiner Bücher behandeln den Gebrauch und die Funktion von Sprichwörtern und Redensarten in der Literatur, den Massenmedien, der Kunst, Werbung und Politik, wie in letzter Zeit etwa *International Bibliography of Paremiology and Phraseology* (2009), *'Spruchschlösser (ab)bauen': Sprichwörter, Antisprichwörter und Lehnsprichwörter in Literatur und Medien* (2010), *'Behold the Proverbs of a*

Including contributions by historians of early modern European art, architecture, and literature, this book examines the transformative force of the vernacular over time and different regions, as well as the way the concept of the vernacular itself changes in the period. In this first comprehensive full length study in English on the art of Jan Brueghel the Elder, Leopoldine Prosperetti illuminates how the work of this painter relates to a philosophical culture prevailing in the Antwerp of his time. She shows that no matter what scenery, figures or objects stock the pictorial field, Brueghel's diverse pictures have something in common: they all embed visual trajectories that allow for the viewer to craft out of the raw material of the picture a moment of spiritual repose. Rooted in the art of Hieronymus Bosch and Pieter Bruegel the Elder these vistas are shown to meet the expectation of viewers to discover in their mazes a rhetorically conceived path to wisdom. The key issue is the ambition of pictorial images to bring into practice the humanist belief that philosophy and rhetoric are inseparable. This original study analyzes the patterns of thought and recurrent optical tropes that constitute a visual poetics for shifting genres - no longer devotional, yet sharing in the meditative goal of redirecting the soul toward an intuitive knowledge of what is good in life. This book reveals how everyday life is the preferred vehicle for delivering the results of philosophical pursuits. One chapter is dedicated to Brueghel's innovative attention to the experience of traveling in a variety of wheeled vehicles along the roads of his native Brabant. He is unique, and surprisingly modern, in giving contemporary viewers an accurate account of all the different types of conveyances that clutter the roads. It makes for lively versions of one of his favorite themes: The Traveled Road. By taking the pursuit of wisdom as its theme, the book succeeds in presenting a new model for the interpretation of a range of visual genres in the Antwerp picture trade.

Imagine a dreamland where roasted pigs wander about with knives in their backs to make carving easy, where grilled geese fly directly into one's mouth, where cooked fish jump out of the water and land at one's feet. The weather is always mild, the wine flows freely, sex is readily available, and all people enjoy eternal youth. Such is Cockaigne. Portrayed in legend, oral history, and art, this imaginary land became the most pervasive collective dream of medieval times—an earthly paradise that served to counter the suffering and frustration of daily existence and to allay anxieties about an increasingly elusive heavenly paradise. Illustrated with extraordinary artwork from the Middle Ages, Herman Pleij's *Dreaming of Cockaigne* is a spirited account of this lost paradise and the world that brought it to life. Pleij takes three important texts as his starting points for an inspired panorama of ideas, dreams, popular religion, and literary and artistic creation present in the late Middle Ages. What emerges is a well-defined picture of the era, furnished with a wealth of detail from all of Europe, as well as Asia and America. Pleij draws upon his thorough knowledge of medieval European literature, art, history, and folklore to describe the fantasies that fed the tales of Cockaigne and their connections to the central obsessions of medieval life. Während in der antiken Mythologie die Fähigkeit zur Tierverwandlung nicht durchweg negative Konnotationen hatte, erfährt die Verwandlung vor allem im christlichen Kontext eine radikale Umdeutung als Fluch und Strafe. Theologen und Dämonologen befürworteten und untermauerten die Möglichkeit der Tierverwandlung einerseits als Realität und andererseits als teuflische Illusion. In den Hexen- und Werwolfprozessen zogen beide Varianten die reale Verwandlung bzw. die durch den Teufel vorgetragene tödliche Konsequenzen für die Beschuldigten nach sich. Über lange Zeit war die Idee der Verwandlung kein stabiles Phänomen, wiewohl der Metamorphoseerzählung eine gewisse Kontinuität der immer wieder variierten Verwandlungstypen eignet. Im Medium Film wurde die Verbildlichung der Verwandlung in Literatur und Kunst fortgeschrieben und einer traditionellen Vorstellung nicht nur zu neuer Popularität, sondern auch zu neuartigen Entwicklungen verholfen. Der interdisziplinäre Sammelband erkundet Varianten und Variationen der Tierverwandlung und nähert sich den unterschiedlichen Codierungen und Diskursen der Metamorphose von der Antike bis in die Jetztzeit.
