The anticompetitive practices of cartels can lead to increased consumer prices and remain an important point on the agenda of antitrust authorities. Almost all of the

current cartels are detected by leniency applications of one of their members because whistle blowing policies allow cartel members to get reductions in fines when they self-report the committed infringements. Before the implementation of these policies, the most crucial threat for internal cartel stability was strategic deviations from the cartel agreement (for example price cuts) by one of the cartel members to increase short-term profits. The risk of being undercut on the one hand and the risk of leniency applications on the other hand place today's cartel firms in a "between-life-and-death" situation in which persistence of the cartel is equally likely as its breakdown.
